A total of 15,274 theft incidents at construction sites were reported by participating agencies in 2015, making up 63% of all construction site incidents.

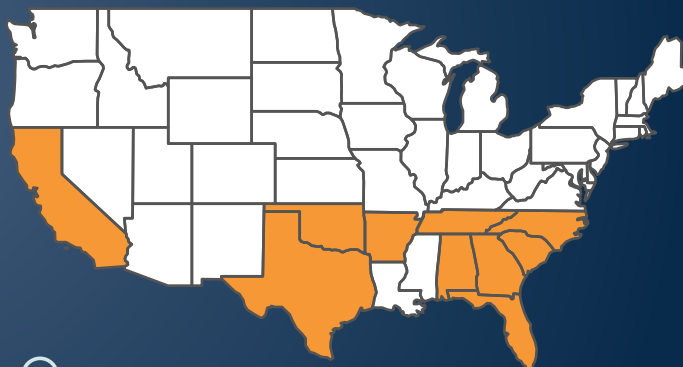
